Tokenisation provides a solution that helps lower your security burden, cut PCI-DSS compliance costs and makes it easier for consumers to pay you.


With most of our services, tokens can be used in place of cards across channels and devices, with future changes designed to deliver more cost savings and encourage repeat business.

What is Tokenisation?

Put simply, Tokenisation replaces a piece of sensitive information, such as a card number, with a non-sensitive 'token' that can be used in its place.

By using this method, it is possible to make repeat purchases without having to store the card data. It also means that the shopper no longer has to enter their details each time they visit your website, so they can pay faster and more conveniently. Once a token is generated, it can be used in any place where a card number can be used; for example, authorisation, risk checks and 3-D Secure.
